Kelli Take's a Winter's Rest

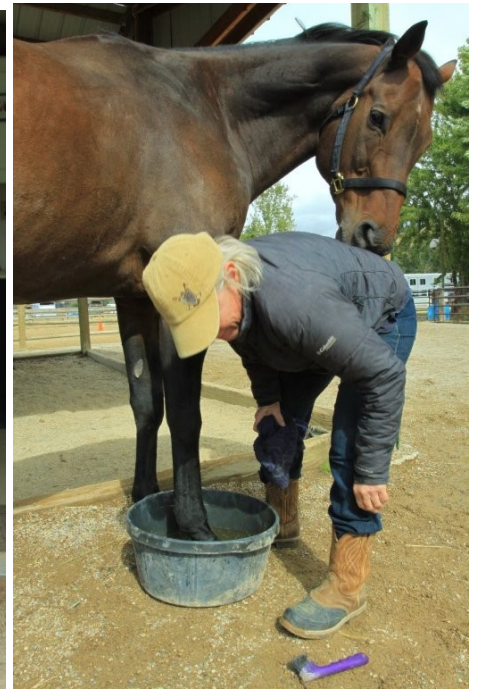

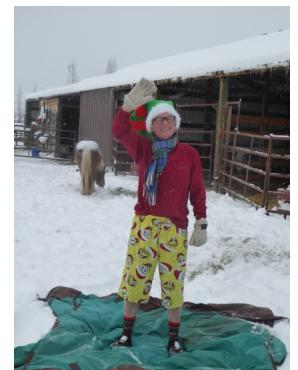
