The Nest Cam

provides intimate views of ospreys during spring and summer and of the colorful birds both big and small that visit the bird feeders in the fall and winter.



The Bench Cam

is at a bird-feeding station, where the fields roll down to the forest along the river. Wildlife of all kinds come to clean up seeds scattered on the ground by the birds.



The River Cam

watches over a world unto itself with foggy morning sunrises, a myriad of water birds, eagles, river otters, deer, coyotes, elk, and a local herd of wild horses.



The Ranch Cam

follows the action in the pastures, riding area, and surrounding valley to capture it all—from spectacular sunsets to the mares teaching their foals to behave.



The experience here can range from long, hot days that end with bright pink sunsets, BIG smiles on happy children's faces as they ride a pony, painting our equine partners to celebrate our bonds, the donkey DIVAS prancing about in the Christmas parade, quiet moments in the mountain forests with the horses and guests from afar, and letting our curiosities lead us to come up with the next great Dunrovin event.
